**JOB DESCRIPTION:** This position is responsible for performing a variety of maintenance and repair services on the city's water and sewer lines and for reading water meters on a monthly basis.

#### **ESSENTIAL JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- 1) Performs routine and emergency maintenance on the city's water and sewer lines.
- 2) Reads and records water meter readings for billing purposes.
- 3) Assist with TV and Vector Truck operations as needed
- 4) Digs up water and sewer lines as necessary, fills holes, packs base, patches road cuts.
- 5) Drives Dump Truck and other equipment associated (trailer, Vector truck, etc)
- 6) Performs other related duties as assigned

#### **SPECIFIC KNOWLEDGE, SKILL AND ABILITIES:**

- 1) Knowledge of the layout of the city.
- 2) Skill in operating various types of repair and maintenance equipment such as pipe saw pipe cutter and various other hand tools.

- 3) Skill in oral communications.
- 4) Skill in following oral instructions.
- 5) Skill in operating Dump truck w/trailer behind

**IMMEDIATE SUPERVISOR:** Supervisor assigns work in terms of specific tasks to be completed. For new and one-time tasks, detailed and specific instructions are given before tasks are begun. Work is spot checked for compliance with procedures.

**PHYSICAL DEMANDS:** The physical demands described herein are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. 
**WORK ENVIRONMENT:** The work environment characteristics described herein are representative of those an employee encounters while performing the essential functions of this job. **WORKING CONDITIONS:** Work is performed outdoors where the employee is exposed too much noise, dirt, dust, grease, irritating chemicals, machinery with moving parts, traffic and inclement weather. Work may require the use of protective devices such as goggles and rubber gloves. Physical demands typically include walking and standing with intermittent bending, crouching and stooping. This position also requires the frequent lifting of light and heavy objects. The use of a shovel, jackhammer, pipe saw, weed eater, lawnmower, etc., may be required. This employee will be required to lift as much as 100 pounds.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- 1) Ability to read, write and perform mathematical calculations.
- 2) Possession of or ability to readily obtain a valid driver's Arkansas Drivers license.
- 3) Position maybe required to cover on-call on weekdays, weekend and/or night work or during emergency situations.
- 4) **Must obtain a CDL License within 6 months of the time hired.** (See CDL License Agreement)
